

Back to basics: promoting, developing and maintaining positive behaviour in the classroom

The establishment of positive behaviour is fundamental to effective teaching and learning.

Course Outline

In the busy classroom it is vital to ensure the basics of promoting positive behaviour are in place, effective learning will simply not happen without it. The central focus of this training course will be how to confidently promote, develop and maintain a classroom culture and environment where learners have high expectations of their own behaviour and are enabled to take ownership of this. Delegates will explore key first principles of effective positive behaviour management and in particular the power of relationships, the need for respectful communication and a hierarchy of responses to the behaviours which do not meet expectations. The influence on learners of extrinsic motivation such as rewards and consequences will be unpicked as will the use of a language of learning.

By the end of the course participants will:-

- understand and be able to put into practice, the first key principles around establishing and maintaining positive behaviour in the classroom
- have a range of strategies to confidently respond to unwanted behaviours with a particular focus on developing self-regulatory behaviours in learners.
- be able to reflect upon and review their own practice to identify key personal next steps.
