It's not easy to learn how to write!

This course will consider how an exciting, play-based learning environment and effective teaching support and improve children's early writing.

Delegates will be given an overview of the main stages of development of early writing, from when children give meaning to marks, to the end of the EYFS. They will explore how an effective learning environment promotes early writing, and consider a variety of teaching strategies that can be used at different developmental stages. There will be opportunities to look at, and share, practical ideas that motivate children to write.

By the end of the training participants will:-

- know how to provide a play based learning environment that supports children as writers
- understand the stages of development in early writing
- plan teaching strategies to enable children's progress in writing.
