

EAL TA Course

A modular TA programme to develop expertise in the field of EAL.

Course Outline

This 10-session course will cover working throughout the primary phase including YR and will focus on developing a toolkit of practical classroom-based strategies which can support the achievement of pupils with English as an Additional Language. Delegates will need to complete tasks between training sessions, produce a portfolio of work and undertake a final assessment.

This course is highly appropriate for use of Pupil Premium and EAL funding.

By the end of the course participants will:

- use the knowledge they have gained to identify their growing EAL population
- be a key person in schools for the dissemination of EAL information and expertise
- be able to use a wide range of strategies to assess, induct, monitor and teach EAL pupils
- understand how EAL pupils learn and be able to use this knowledge to develop differentiated resources.
