

# Middle Leaders: Making Moderation Work

This half day training event will equip delegates with the necessary skills to facilitate effective inschool (and cluster) moderation against the interim teacher assessment frameworks for Y2 and Y6.

## Course Outline

The 2017 Teacher Assessment External Moderation requirements state that schools must have moderated internally prior to being moderated by the Local Authority. Middle leaders must be confident in leading sessions based upon effective professional dialogue and a secure understanding of the evidence base.

## Delegates will:

- explore the key skills of professional dialogue
- understand how to organise and facilitate an effective moderation session
- understand the importance of standardisation
- be able to evaluate the accuracy of judgements made and provide appropriate feedback

## Delegates will need to bring:

- interim teacher assessment frameworks for KS1 and 2
- an evidence base for writing for a Y2 and Y6 pupil
