A stimulating, challenging and inspiring environment is a crucial factor in providing all children with an engaging and effective Early Years' experience. This course will help you in identifying and planning an environment which will support meaningful teaching, learning and assessment opportunities.

Course Outline

Delegates will have the opportunity to reflect on what works well in their own environment, and develop and share ideas for how to improve. This will involve looking at continuous provision, how to manage child-led learning, providing enhancements and building-in challenge. The course will also include a visit to the Best Practice exhibition space at Woodside.

- Problem solve and plan ways to improve your own environment
- Understand how to enhance your environment in simple ways, and provide on-going challenge for children
