

The Cleverness of Boys

This course will provide practitioners with ideas about how to match provision with boys' learning styles, aiding their progress in Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Communication and Language, Physical Development and Writing.

Course Outline

Boys continue to do less well than girls in all areas of learning in the EYFS and continue to lag behind girls in assessments throughout their school careers.

Key points that will be explored over the 2 days will include:

- The environment we can create to enable boys to become confident and autonomous learners
- Ways that participants can evaluate and enhance provision to improve levels of wellbeing and involvement
- Physical development and the value of active, challenging and adventurous play
- Practical ways to stimulate language development
- Practical ways to help boys to become confident and capable writers by supporting them to write in ways that make sense to them
- Planned activities and rich experiences that support holistic learning in an inspiring environment

Outcomes

- Developed knowledge and understanding of the specific styles and needs of boys
- Identified how to create stimulating places and spaces that promote boys' learning
- Understand how to plan to promote boys' self esteem and motivation as learners
- Gained new ideas to enable to reach their full potential as learners
