An active training day for KS2 Teachers and TAs offering ideas to support the KS2 Stone Age History unit, English and cross-curricular work.

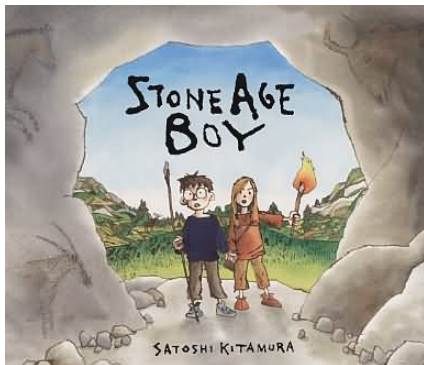
