Sally Thomas, National Early Years Consultant, is returning to Norfolk to deliver some guided tours for reception teachers.

Holistic learning and development happens when children are actively engaged in an environment that really interests them, where they can explore and discover alongside fully engaged adults whom they trust, where they can play with ideas as well as materials, and are able to freely return to re-examine and re-adjust their thinking.

The current Best Practice Space focuses on three year olds and, as reception teachers, it's important to have time to reflect on the point children have reached before they come into school at age four.

The environment for three year olds builds on the previous one for two year olds with 'home' remaining vitally important for three and four year olds, but the space now reflects the growing interest of three year olds in their locality as well as their own home.
