- Develop positive staff- parent interactions
- Overcome the barriers to parental engagement, especially for the parents who find it hardest to reach schools
- Help parents understand the curriculum, how well their child is doing and how they can support them at home
- Use the parental voice to further improve the school's effectiveness
- Make best use of community assets to enhance pupils' education
