Educational Psychology and Specialist Support Traded Services Model and Charges, 2017 – 2018

- 1. Cluster Contracts (also available for groups of clusters/schools): Enhanced Core Offer
 - An EPSS multi-professional service for designated groups of schools for an agreed number of days per week. Features:
 - a named Coordinating professional who is the customer's first point of contact
 - depending on specific need, access to the EPSS multidisciplinary services via your Coordinating professional
 - termly operational meeting (usually lasting 0.5 days if one EPSS professional attends and 1 day if the customer choses tw0 EPSS professionals to attend), where work is negotiated and prioritised
 - broadly even distribution of the EPSS time throughout the year.
 - Charges are also given for when clusters want the majority of time (66.6% or more) delivered by a specific professional (e.g. EP, SLST). Please speak to JT / HB / JB
 - Cost per day decreases as amount of time purchased increases
 - 1.1 **EPSS Subscription**. Access to: one day a year consultation time; EPSS Webinars and forums; the full EPSS website and, to one free place a year at EPSS conferences. (£600) (Available free to partner schools with contracts of more than 10 days a year)
 - 1.2 **ECO Bronze**. EPSS availability for average of one day a week during school year: £8,560 (£428 per day)

(May be of particular interest to very small clusters or groups of schools)

1.3 **ECO_Silver**: EPSS availability for average of one day a week during school year: £16,263 (£417 per day)

(May be of particular interest to small clusters or groups of schools)

1.4 **ECO Gold**: EPSS availability for average of two days a week during school year: **£30,966** (£397 a day)

(May be of particular interest to medium to large clusters or groups of schools)

1.5 **ECO Platinum**: EPSS availability for average of three days a week or more during school year: £377 a day.

Example of three days a week contract: £44,109

(May be of particular interest to large clusters/groups of clusters)

- 2. School Contracts: Block Purchase
 - EPSS multi-professional service for individual schools
 - a named Coordinating professional who is the customer's first point of contact
 - depending on specific need, access to the EPSS multidisciplinary services via your Coordinating professional
 - termly operational meeting (usually lasting 0.5 days if one EPSS professional attends and 1 day if the customer choses tw0 EPSS professionals to attend), where work is negotiated and prioritised

- broadly even distribution of the EPSS time throughout the year.
- Minimum contract of 3 days per year
- Typical contract calculated at £438 per day

NB: Typical contract assumes even split between EP / teacher time Tailored contracts e.g. (EP / SLST only) can also be offered - if interested contact JT / HB / JB.

- 3. Specific packages (time-agreed specialist work)
 - Purchase specialist interventions to meet identified needs for a fixed time and price
 - Purchase training or cluster/school development activities, at a price agreed at the outset
 - Purchase professional support not covered elsewhere in the EPSS offer
 - Daily rate: £468
 - 4.1 <u>Specialist Interventions</u>: Delivery of specialist interventions (e.g teaching of pupils with dyslexia/Solution Focused Interventions /Therapeutic Story Writing/Cognitive Behaviour Therapy/Stress Management for pupils/Support for children with ASD). Most interventions take two days of staff time and the costing will be calculated on the base tariff rate.
 - 4.2 <u>Project work and training</u>: £125 per initial consultation then package and price to be agreed

Each cluster/school has a named EPSS professional (the Coordinating Educational Psychologist or CEP) who can discuss the various packages in more detail.
