

Suffolk & Norfolk SCITT Offers New Part-time Secondary Teacher Training

Suffolk & Norfolk SCITT has just won a further government bid to promote and develop part-time teacher training courses for the secondary phase, especially in Maths, Physics and Languages but places are also available in Chemistry, Biology, Computing and Geography. Training is already underway with a pilot group and a new round of recruitment has begun for September 2017.

Just like the full time courses, the new part-time courses offer trainee teachers a school based teacher training with a Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE), Master's credits and Qualified Teacher status. Trainees can follow either student or employment based programmes.
