Providing Enterprise Education in Primary Schools

Course Outline

Inspiration about enterprise should begin at an early age when children are open to the ideas and influences which will shape their futures. This course shows primary schools how to use the vehicle of Enterprise Cafés to develop Key Stage 2 pupils' awareness and understanding of the world of work and enterprise, see the link between achievement at school and later life, widen their aspirations, develop employability and enterprise skills, increase their motivation and drive for achievement as well as develop their sense of self efficacy and self-esteem. Pupils' parents are invited to be part of the Enterprise Café.

By the end of the course participants will:

- Understand what is meant by enterprise education
- Be aware of key enterprise and employability skills
- Be able to plan and deliver a variety of Enterprise Café sessions
- Have begun action planning for the introduction of Enterprise Cafés, with a secure understanding of how to evaluate impact on pupil and adult outcomes as well as aspects of school improvement
