Norfolk Children's University were delighted to see over 200 children graduate at ceremonies across the county in February. Children between the ages of 5 and 12 had collected stamps in their Passport to Learning by completing learning activities at many of the 230 public learning destinations before attending one of the ceremonies. There were graduations at the College of West Anglia, Dragon Hall and Great Yarmouth College.
