Please note: The JCQ deadline for all Access Arrangement Assessors to have successfully completed a Level 7 or equivalent postgraduate course in individual specialist assessment is 31 August 2017

- Become familiar with theories about testing & psychometrics
- Understand the legislative and policy framework
- Select, evaluate, administer and interpret different types of educational tests
- Carry out an assessment of a learner and report the findings
