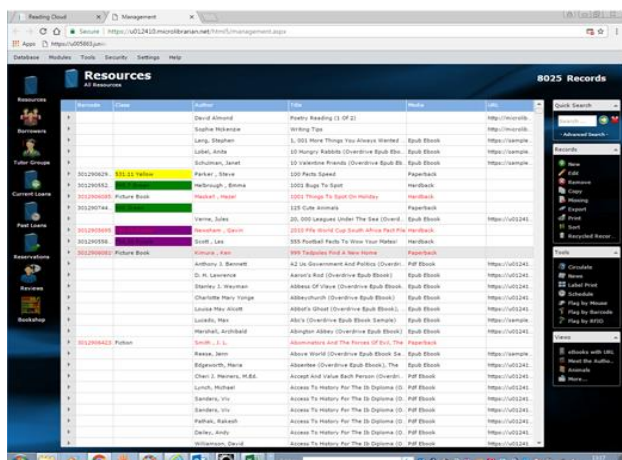
A half-day INSET course to help your school to get maximum value from the full range of features of this library management software (Suitable for those new to the system and those who have recently upgraded from Junior 3)
