The provision will be through TSST Secondary Maths and the details of the course are detailed in this document.

You will complete a series of learning **modules in mathematics**. Alongside this you will receive training in the **best ways to teach mathematics** from leading experts and outstanding mathematics teachers. You will also have the opportunity to **share ideas and practice with colleagues**.

The course contains elements of assessment on both **mathematics subject knowledge and pedagogy**, and you will receive a Certificate of Mathematical Mastery at the end which will verify your new status as a teacher of mathematics.
