Subject Area	Textiles – will cover key principles underpinning KS3
Date	Monday 3 rd July and Tuesday 11 th July
Content	 The two days will give delegates opportunities to develop the following skills: Make and adapt simple patterns for products. Develop practical skills including understanding how to: Make seams and finish them including knowing and being able to neaten seams Ways of disposing of fullness in fabrics – darts, gathers, Apply fastenings e.g. Velcro, zips, buttonholes Apply different types of embellishing to fabrics e.g. appliqué, fabric printing techniques, embroidery Look at how fabrics are constructed and the properties of fibres and fabrics.

Subject Area	Food – will cover key principles underpinning KS3
Date	Tuesday 20 th June and Monday 10 th July
Content	 The two days will give delegates opportunities to develop the following skills: Basic cooking techniques used at KS 3 Develop practical skills and understand the scientific principles behind them. To understand how to work safely when carrying out practical activities in food lessons.

Subject Area	Resistant Materials / Product Design – will cover key principles underpinning KS3
Date	Wednesday 12 th July and Friday 14 th July
Content	The days will focus on developing sketching skills and understanding the range of materials, components and processes used in Design Technology departments. Basic workshop equipment, including scroll-saws, pillar drills, disk sander and vacuum former, will be covered by working on practical tasks in woods, metals, and plastics. You will have the opportunity to develop your skills using wood and plastics. There will be an emphasis on Health and Safety throughout the course
