We have had some wonderful feedback from pupils and staff this academic year on the **RSPB Norwich Schools Outreach Programme**. The RSPB, working in partnership with Aldi supermarket chain, has been offering free environmental education sessions to primary schools in Norwich and the Broads for two hugely successful years. We have had a brilliant time working with over 4000 primary school children this academic year. All of our activities are high quality, fun and interactive and we hold the **Learning Outside the Classroom Quality Badge**.

We are now taking bookings for 2017-18. Sessions book up very quickly, so do get in touch soon.

During the Autumn Term, our trained educators can deliver a choice of the following two sessions, at **no cost to your school.** 

<u>**Give Nature a Home**</u> – Find out all about the habitats in your school, what already exists and where the opportunities are to create more. We help your pupils map and score your school grounds for wildlife: a great springboard for ideas to develop your school grounds to help nature.

**<u>Bioblitz</u>** (until October half-term) – What's living in your school grounds? We'll help your pupils look for plants, trees, animal signs and hunt for minibeasts under every rock and bush. You may be surprised by what you find!

All of our visits have been carefully designed to meet learning outcomes from the National Curriculum for Science and can be geared towards KS1 or KS2. There are many follow up activities you can use to complete learning outcomes for other curriculum areas, for example in numeracy. Each lesson lasts 90 minutes.

## This offer is currently limited to primary schools in Norwich and the Broads area. The visits can also be counted towards your Eco Schools Award.
