



Norfolk Healthy Child Programme

A new model for 5–19 year old's has been developed in conjunction with HCP staff, related stakeholders, children, young people and agreed by our Public Health commissioners.

Objectives:



Targeting resources to areas and school clusters identified as being in greatest need;



Supporting transition to school, high school and adulthood,



Developing a workforce which includes greater skill mix.



Identified priorities for children and young people in Norfolk.



Signposting schools to online resources and specialist organisations for PSHE, medicines management and training.



Increased partnership work, with service development and resource for complex needs, short stay schools and those out of education.



Increasing use of technology, such as the texting service ChatHealth



Evaluating the impact of all interventions with children and young people.



Promoting access to health services for 16-19 year olds.

From SEPTEMBER 2017 Onwards:

All localities will have Specialist Community Public Health Nurse/Nurses leading a skill mix team who will provide individual interventions with children and young people.
