

New Statutory Training For Designated Teachers for Looked After Children

This course is updated training for new and experienced Designated Teachers* to keep education on the agenda for all Looked After Children. It is led by the Education Achievement Service's Virtual School for Children in Care.

The course will cover:

- The Statutory Duties of the Designated Teacher (DT)
- The importance of the Designated Teacher for LAC
- Personal Education Plans
- Attachment, trauma and resilience
- Key people around Looked After Children

By the end of the course participants will have:

- Recognition of their key contribution to supporting attainment and maintaining a focus on teaching and learning for LAC.
- An overview of the legislation relating to the statutory role of the DT for LAC, how they can support good outcomes for LAC including, understanding the systems and processes in place around LAC and their relationship to education.
- A toolkit to take back to school to support both them and their colleagues in promoting the educational attainment of LAC.

*Statutory guidance for school governing bodies 2009 states that the person appointed as designated teacher within a school must be:

Reg 3(2) A qualified teacher working in the school

Reg3(3) A head teacher or acting head teacher of a school
