Why should you join us?

If you are a professional working with people then it is likely that you will be working with clients affected by sexual abuse. This conference is aimed at professionals who are not specialists in this area, and is designed to give you the confidence, knowledge and skills you need to respond appropriately when the issue crops up in your everyday work. The conference will include a number of speakers who are expert in their field.

Day One will focus on the signs and symptoms of child sexual abuse, the impact on children and how we respond to it.

Day Two will focus on understanding the impact of childhood sexual abuse on adults and developing an appropriate professional response.

The conference will cost £75 for one day's attendance or £100 for both days.
