

Understanding the knowledge based curriculum

Recent research and policy announcements on the curriculum have pointed to the concept of Powerful Disciplinary Knowledge, which consists of the knowledge and ideas that link to and build toward new knowledge.

Course Outline

This course examines how learning experiences can build such knowledge and in so doing create a coherent curriculum with meaningful links between subjects.

The day begins by applying these ideas to science, geography and history and then extends the approach to other foundation subjects.

By the end of the course delegates will:

- identify powerful disciplinary knowledge in the foundation subjects of the National Curriculum
- know what constitutes a powerful pedagogy in each subject area
- construct programmes of study in each subject based on these concepts.
