# Getting it right: Assessing KS1 Mathematics



Be confident you understand the KS1 mathematics criteria and are accurately assessing your children's work against the statutory framework.

#### **Course Outline**

Delegates will have the opportunity to explore and unpick the framework through professional discussion led by a subject specialist. Through an exploration of the statutory criteria, delegates will be equipped with the subject knowledge they need to assess accurately. There will also be the opportunity to look at examples of children's work, to confirm understanding of the expectation.

There is also a follow up, hands-on session 'Getting it right: Collaborative mathematics moderation KS1' later in the year, which participants may benefit from. This will be an opportunity to work with teachers in other schools or clusters in a supportive, collaborative environment.

- leave more confident they can accurately apply the framework across children's mathematical work
- know which aspects of subject knowledge they need to develop
- make accurate and robust teacher assessment judgements.
