Developing Geography in the Primary Curriculum

Course Outline

Geography has a distinctive part to play in the school curriculum, as it is a resource that can enable learners to better understand the world and their place in it.

This course builds a long term plan by first exploring and including the core concepts and skills of the geography, and then supporting the subject leader in creating and developing aspects of geography that are most relevant to their school; and locality.

There will be an emphasis on fieldwork and skills development throughout the course.

By the end of the course participants will:-

- identify the core knowledge of the geographical programme of study in the National Curriculum
- build a school programme in Geography that is tailored to the needs and locality of the school
- identify real opportunities for meaningful writing and mathematics across the curriculum
- describe the progression of skills in the Geography curriculum
