

Identifying Harmful Sexual Behaviour in Children and Young People

This is a **free** 90 minute workshop for Designated Safeguarding Leads and Headteachers run by The Harmful Sexual Behaviour Team.

Aim

To increase professionals' confidence in consistently identifying potentially harmful sexual behaviour in children and young people and understanding levels of concern in respect of this.

Learning Outcomes

By the end of this workshop participants will be able to:

- Begin to understand a 'common language' and terminology around Harmful Sexual Behaviour in children and young people
- Understand how to use the Brook Traffic Light tool for early identification of HSB in children and young people
- Understand how to use the Brook Traffic Light tool to identify potential levels of concern about Harmful Sexual Behaviour
- Think about 'next steps' for training for their organisation in assessment and intervention for Harmful Sexual Behaviour
