This is an externally accredited course for those working with children aged 5-11 years. Designed to be delivered over ten weekly sessions (each session lasts two and half hours) the course uses interactive teaching methods, practical activities, videos and group discussion to engage learners. It provides information and strategies to develop the communication skills of all children but especially those with speech, language and communication needs (see below)

What will the course cover?

The course will provide you with practical skills to support the communication development of all children in the classroom. You will complete a portfolio, adding to it each week; this will help to put into practice what you learn on the course. Participants will receive a Level 2 or Level 3 nine credit Award in Knowledge and Practice to Support the Communication Skills of 5-11s – both levels are now on the Qualification and Credit Framework.

A portfolio of evidence will need to be submitted.

- What is communication?
- Understanding non-verbal communication, developing listening and attention skills
- Developing memory and independent learning
- Modifying adults' speech to help a child understand language
- Understanding beyond simple sentences
- Promoting vocabulary development
- Encouraging expressive language development and storytelling skills
- Promoting effective communication and social skills
- Supporting children with unclear speech and exploring the link between speech, reading and writing
- Management of stammering and other issues raised during the course
