- **Soils and composting** - compare soil and learn why it's so important.
- **Planting and growing** - lifecycles, pollination, seed dispersal, trees
- **Working sheepdog displays** – and meet the animals involved!
- **Wonders of wool** - explore properties of wool and woolly crafts.
- **Coming soon!** Our red squirrels will be returning to the farm!

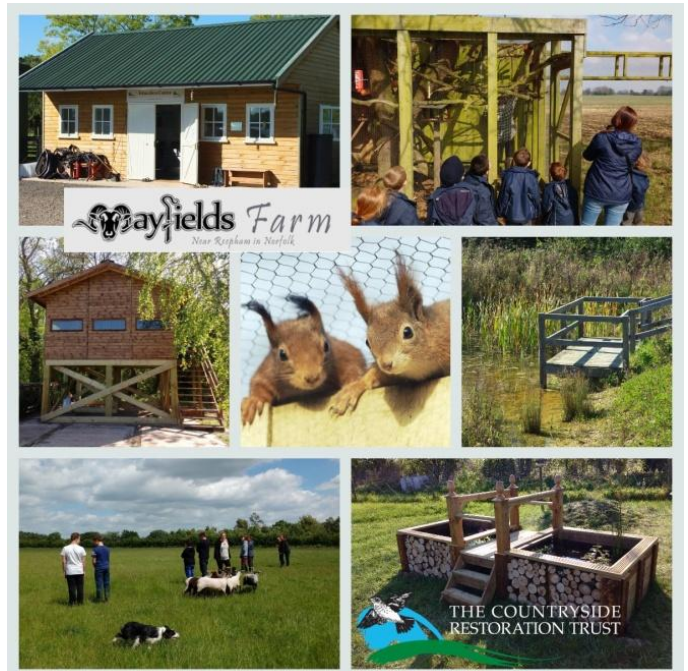
