The Plantation Garden is a Grade II English Heritage-registered garden close to Norwich City centre, next to the Catholic Cathedral.

Its features include a Gothic fountain, lawns, an Italianate terrace, a 'Medieval' wall, flower beds, a summerhouse, woodland walkways and a rustic bridge.
