Online safety action planning and CEOP training (accredited)



This full day course is designed to support high-quality leadership and management of online safety, including resources to support curriculum teaching of online safety across all key stages.

Course Outline

Keeping children and young people safe online and teaching them about the appropriate and responsible use of the internet is an essential part of a school's safeguarding role. This course looks at what schools need to do to in order to make online safety a priority across all areas of the school. As part the day, full CEOP Think You Know Training will be provided, including certification.

By the end of the course participants will:-

- look at young people's use of the internet and the latest online trends
- consider how the teaching of online safety can be embedded into the curriculum
- cover the expectations from Ofsted around online safety and how to meet these
- consider how schools can engage with parents around online safety
- discuss the policies and procedures relating to online safety which schools should have in place.

All delegates attending the training must bring a signed, headed letter from their organisation. This letter should be from senior management at their organisation and state the delegate's role and length of employment with the organisation they are representing, the relevance of this training to their role and confirm that the organisation has undertaken necessary risk assessments to ensure that the delegate is suitable to work with children and young people.
