

Norfolk Steps 'Step On' Service Tutor Training



Become a Steps Tutor in your setting to train and support colleagues in the Step On curriculum.

Course Outline

Investing in this 3 day course will equip you with the skills and knowledge of the Step On curriculum to train your colleagues, maintain their Step On certification and to continually influence practice within your own context. This course will be grounded in the Steps principles of developing therapeutic approaches to behaviour and will be delivered through a practical, interactive approach. Participants are likely to be those who already have a therapeutic attitude to children and young people and an ability to train colleagues in the Step On knowledge and physical skills.

By the end of the course participants will:-

- understand the theoretical principles that underpin the Step On curriculum
- have knowledge of how to apply a range of de-escalation strategies
- know how to use and demonstrate safe use of physical intervention
- be confident in delivering the Step On curriculum in their own setting.

Important Information:

Norfolk Steps Service Tutors are certificated to be a resource for the setting in which they work.

Service tutors are not certified to provide training or consultancy on a voluntary or paid basis outside of their school or setting.

Delegates will also be required to attend a one day refresher per year at an additional cost.

Two delegates from each school is advisable but not essential.
