Course Outline

- EAL assessment frameworks and resources to use in EAL initial language assessment
- Essential strategies to support EAL learners (from beginners to more advanced learners)
- Examples of documents such as EAL register, EAL profiles, EAL assessment frameworks
- Demonstrations of a variety of resources which support EAL, including English language learning software and online packages, bi-lingual resources, Apps, books etc
- Advice and resources to assist in the assessment of EAL pupils with SEN
- Information for parents and EAL communities e.g. English lessons (ESOL) , first language teaching for children and organisations providing new arrivals with support
- Guidance on access arrangements for EAL in GCSEs
- Information on first language GCSEs
- Information about supporting Unaccompanied Asylum Seekers / refugees.
