Global Gardens



Plants produce a stunning array of chemicals, many of which are valuable natural products used by humans. Some of the most interesting plant species are found in remote locations across the globe

where often indigenous people have a long-standing relationship with the natural products they produce.

The Global Gardens workshop begins with hands on science activities, real plant case studies and a discussion of the aims of scientists using them. Harnessing these scientific ideas and images, participants will be invited to give their personal response to the relationship between plants, chemicals and people through poetry and collaborative art. The resulting work will be used by academics for further research in the field.

The next Global Gardens workshop will be held as part of the Norwich Science Festival, on Thursday the 25th of October, at the Millennium Library and is free to all attendees.
