This course is for you if you are:

an adult working with students with dyslexia in a professional capacity
 (please note that for this course you will need to be able to work with the same learner with dyslexia on a weekly basis)

Prior Knowledge: The course builds on the foundations established in the Level 1 & 3 Dyslexia Awareness courses, although there is no requirement for you to have done these first. However, you must have a good basic knowledge of dyslexia, the issues faced by learners with dyslexia and be aware of the most common strategies & approaches.

Course Content:

- Prioritise learning objectives
- Understand the language of professional assessment reports
- Assess the suitability of available intervention programmes
- Involve and empower your learner
- Monitor progress in every session
- Adjust and plan sessions in the light of your observations
- Communicate intervention outcomes to your line manager, your pupils and parents
- Make a new plan for your learner

Course Fee: £350 per person (£315 to DOS members), to include dyslexia friendly resources.
