

Online Safety for Lead Professionals Update & refresher

This course is aimed at teachers who completed the CEOP Accredited training before September 2015, and now require updating and refreshing in this constantly changing area.

Course Outline

Schools have increasingly been on the front line of being online, with school staff and leadership teams expected to deal with a whole host of complex issues related to online safety. This refresher course will provide sharply focused training to senior management who lead on online safety in their school. It will focus on the most up to date requirements, including how schools are ensuring that all staff have appropriately trained and how to engage the wider school community. This course would be suitable for any staff who have completed the CEOP Accredited training before 2016 – all phases from EYFS to KS5.

- To have a clear understanding of the current trends in online technologies used by children and young people and the benefits and risks associated with them.
- To be equipped to ensure that policies and practice are up to date and meet the needs of the school.
- Communities have information to ensure that their schools can provide an effective progressive online safety curriculum.
- To be able to adapt their online safety curriculum in line with ongoing updates.
