PROGRAMME CONTENT

Year 1

3 Sessions each Saturday as follows:

10.30 - 11.30 Junior choir

The emphasis is on having fun whilst students develop their vocal skills, covering a range of repertoire and styles and learning to sing together in harmony and different parts.

11.30 -11.45 Break

11.45 -12.30 Instrumental session

A 45-minute group instrumental lesson of whole class strings. Students will learn together on their instruments to acquire the skills and fine muscle control necessary to establish good string technique.

12.30 - 13.00 Junior Musicianship

This session focuses on musical skills inspired by Dalcroze and Kodally to help develop rhythm, pitch, movement and listening - all an essential part of any musicians toolkit!

Year 2

Students will continue with the same activities but will have the option of applying for an individual lesson.

They will also have the opportunity to join other ensembles as part of the morning activities at NCYM.
