Workshop 2 with Rose Keating: Reasoning Through the Four Operations

This workshop will give you a whistle-stop tour of mathematical reasoning skills and how these are assessed through the context of the four operations. We will share with you a wealth of ideas and activities, so that you can equip your learners with reasoning skills.

Workshop 3 with Anna Hogg: Measuring Up!

Children encounter measurement in many contexts everyday as they explore and try make sense of the world. Therefore, this workshop will explore the development of measurement concepts and skills, to help us understand how we measure in a meaningful way and develop "measurement sense". You will investigate measurement relationships, be provided with opportunities to reason mathematically and apply measurement skills in problem solving situations.
