Do you feel confident to effectively engage parents on RSE?

Effective Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) is a triangulation between school, parent and pupil. The new guidance places a duty on schools to work closely with parents when planning and delivering relationships and sex education. Effective RSE consultation with parents can help parents understand the purpose and importance of RSE in keeping their children healthy and safe. It can also support parents to build on RSE in the home, developing important channels of communication with their child. By reducing the fear of parental backlash schools are empowered to deliver high-quality, needs led RSE.
