Early Talk Boost is a targeted, evidence-based intervention for 3 to 4 year old children with delayed language, boosting their communication skills to help them catch up with their peers. The intervention is delivered three times per week during circle/story time by a trained early years practitioner to up to eight children over a nine week period. Evaluation showed that after *Early Talk Boost* children made on average six months progress. The training will give participants the skills and knowledge to;

- Understand the rationale behind Early Talk Boost,
- Identify appropriate children for the intervention programme
- Measure their progress
- Deliver the intervention successfully

The programme is delivered in primary schools by classroom teachers and teaching assistants and provides a structured programme that boosts children's progress in language and communication by an average of 9 - 18 months after a ten week intervention.

Talk Boost KS1 training is for teachers and teaching assistants, training in pairs. It is recommended that staff attend in teacher and teaching assistant training pairs, as this is the structure that the intervention is based around. However, we can discuss your individual requirements.

Talk Boost KS2 covers the areas of language and communication which are key skills for children to support them to access the curriculum, to use their language to interact in the classroom and to form and maintain friendships.

Talk Boost KS2 training is for teachers and teaching assistants, training in pairs. It is recommended that staff attend in teacher and teaching assistant training pairs, as this is the structure that the intervention is based around. However, we can discuss your individual requirements.
