Intent: evidencing the computing curriculum with appropriate coverage, content, structure and sequencing and implementing it effectively

Implementation: demonstrating subject knowledge, presentation of material, assessment, and feedback

Impact: collating first-hand evidence of how pupils are doing, drawing together evidence from pupil interviews, observations, work scrutinies and documentary reviews.

The meetings will also provide:

- support and guidance on creating and updating strategic development plans
- an overview of new and developing technologies
- training and support on new and existing devices, on-line tools, programs and apps
- updates on local and national initiatives related to the all areas of the Computing Curriculum
