In October 2018, Norfolk County Council introduced a new process for allocating SEND funding for children & young people with an EHC Plan in mainstream schools and academies and those with high needs at SEN Support

- Mapping & costing provision against SEN notional budget

- Be fully informed about the process including moderation
- Use the guidance provided at training to complete an application form for funding
