Using the Boxall Profile Online assessment, sessions are planned and built on children's individual developmental needs with the aim to improve their fundamental characteristics of learning, and help children maintain their school placements.

Learning through creativity.

Tuesdays @ the Hub from 29th October 2019 to 11th February 2020

Hands on learning using a variety of art techniques, artefacts, music, literature and the outdoor environment. Students will discover more about themselves as communicators, observers, thinkers and problem solvers.

Learning through science, technology, engineering, art and maths- STEAM!

Wednesdays @ the Hub from 30th October 2019 to 12th February 2020

An exciting range of STEAM activities to promote communication, exploration and problem solving as teams and individuals. Through discovery and experiential learning children will develop skills needed to be successful learners.

Students will be guided and encouraged to work independently and collaboratively, making connections in their learning and identifying transferable skills they have as independent learners.

All sessions are run in small groups by a qualified teacher and a skilled Nurture Support Assistant. Session costs include all resources, snacks and a healthy lunch.
