Course Outline

You will explore how to stimulate geographical learning that is relevant, authentic and progressive in order to raise the standard of teaching and learning in the subject. The session will also examine how real world geography engages pupils in their own learning across the entire curriculum and whole-school initiatives, such as: global learning, sustainability, values and learning outside the classroom.

By the end of the session delegates will:

- gain insight and understanding of a range of leadership and management tools to enable successful geography in your school
- understand core geography knowledge and skills within the context of the national curriculum
- consider factors that may influence how you plan your geography curriculum
- examine a framework for assessment in geography
- explore a range of practical ideas for teaching high-quality geography (including some cross-curricular opportunities)
