- **Day 1 – Being Restorative:** aims to strengthen relationship-based practice and encourages participants to think about their communication and responses to challenging behaviour, as well as to learn new responses to help manage challenging situations.
- **Day 2 – Follow up session; Being Restorative with people on Tuesday, 2 June 2020 in Norwich:** open to anyone who has already completed day 1 (Being Restorative) and who wants to deepen their knowledge of RA and develop practical skills to work with people.

The training is aimed at governors, headteachers and leadership teams.
