The Norfolk Schools Art Competition is an annual competition which takes place at the Royal Norfolk Show.

The winning artwork in each category is displayed at the Show and prize giving takes place on Thursday 2 July 2020.

The theme for 2020 is **GROWN IN NORFOLK**

We ask pupils to submit their entries in any medium. Due to display space, we ask that entries are no larger than A3. There's is no limit to the number of entries per school.

The winning entries will be on display at the Royal Norfolk Show on 1 & 2 July 2020 and prize giving will take place on Thursday 2 July 2020.

The competition age groups are:

- Early Years Foundation Stage & Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2)
- Key Stage 2 Lower (Year 3 & Year 4)
- Key Stage 2 Higher (Year 5 & Year 6)
- Key Stage 3 (Year 7, Year 8 & Year 9)

For each age group, there will be a 1st prize of £50 and a runner-up prize of £25 (certificates and rosettes will awarded to winning entries).

The competition is open to all schools across East Anglia. Judging will take place after the closing date and schools will be notified where entrants have been placed.
