Supporting children with attachment needs within the school setting

Outline

Early attachment experiences are considered to be a crucial precursor for later social relationships and the development of emotional and stress regulation. Children and young people who have experienced insecure attachments are more likely to struggle in these areas, and to experience emotional and behavioural difficulties. School staff can play a vital role in improving the resilience and emotional wellbeing of children who experience such difficulties. This training session is therefore designed for all school staff who work alongside children with attachment needs.

Description

This training session will briefly cover the theoretical underpinnings of attachment theory, but primarily focus on the behavioural presentation associated with attachment difficulties within the school environment. Classroom support strategies will be suggested in relation to different styles of attachment, and the impact of COVID-19 will be discussed.
