The Norwich Opportunity Area has established a network of Communication Champions in schools, nurseries and early years settings across the city to create a universal approach to improving speech and language. This network is led by five Communication Hubs who work in partnership, led by Stuart Allen, Headteacher at Mile Cross Primary School.

As part of this project, we are offering access to free, online speech, language and communication training to staff in any school or setting in Norfolk (and beyond).

Training has been written by The Communication Trust and will include:

- Core modules: understanding speech, language and communication; identification and assessment of need; the communication environment; strategies and support for children with SLCN.
- Intermediate modules: attention, listening and understanding; vocabulary and expressive language; speech sounds and involving children with SLCN.
