Overview

Early Talk Boost is a targeted, evidence-based intervention for 3 to 4 year old children with delayed language, boosting their communication skills to help them catch up with their peers. The intervention is delivered three times per week during circle/story time by a trained early years practitioner to up to eight children over a nine week period. Early Talk Boost children make on average six months progress.

- Identify appropriate children for the intervention programme
- Learn how to measure their progress
- Be able to deliver the intervention successfully
