

Maths Week Workshops

Angles Maths Hub is excited to present “Think of a number...” workshops to Year 2 classes across Norfolk and Suffolk, as part of Maths Week 2020.

These free, online, live sessions support pupils’ reasoning and problem solving and builds upon their early KS1 number knowledge.

During these two linked webinars children will explore different types of number and share their reasoning about what is and isn’t possible as they work to create examples and non-examples. Discussion within the wider mathematical community of classes taking part from different schools, will encompass learning from others’ ideas, listening to and commenting on explanations and collaboratively problem solving together as we use contributions as springboards to further everyone’s understanding.

Resources needed

- Each pair of children will need a set of 0-9 digit cards to work with. (These could be homemade from card or post-its.)
- Pencils and paper, or write-on wipe-off whiteboards and pens.
