An online course for teachers looking to take on, or develop, their book-based approach in school. The Literacy Tree 'Teach through a Text' approach to the teaching of primary English will be actively demonstrated.

THIS COURSE WILL COVER -

- How a book-based approach can provide coverage of the entire programme of study for English.
- An exploration of important children's literature and what makes a quality teaching text.
- How we create meaningful contexts for writing using children's literature by embedding all elements as part of the 'Teach Through a Text' approach.

WE WILL DO THIS BY -

- Giving delegates the opportunity to look at children's writing outcomes where a book-based curriculum has been used.
- Go through a text and planning sequence, modelling how the 'Teach through a Text' approach can be used effectively within the teaching of English.
