

Using Summative Assessment for Progression – all year groups in KS1 and 2

Outline

This is a programme of support to enable all teachers to make confident end of year assessments, consider the information within a continuum of learning within and across subjects, and use the information to ensure a seamless transition to the next year group. The resources and online training will enable all teachers to:

- assess core content of subjects from across the curriculum in year groups 1-6;
- establish the information that this gives in relation to the continuum of learning outlined in the National Curriculum
- use the information above to report to parents and form the basis of discussions and/or key information packs used in transition, to enable each child to continue through their educational journey successfully.

It is strongly recommended that Y7 colleagues also attend.

Description:

The training will consist of:

- Electronic resources to support teacher assessment, reporting and transition
- Online training 1.5 hours in length
- An optional 30-minute surgery slot to discuss individual issues and difficulties relating to making end of year assessments. This will be available on 15th June 2021. Booking for these will be explained at the online training event.

Outcome:

Teachers will be enabled to:

- Make accurate assessments using core content of subjects across the curriculum
- Use the continuum of learning from the National Curriculum, across the primary phase, to establish future actions for effective progression
- Understand how to assess attainment that may be less typical
- Use the information in the most helpful format for transitions
- Use the information to effectively report to parents
